George B., of Englewood Cliffs, NJ, was born on May 26, 1940. He departed this life on October 21, 2015.



An enthusiastic historian, George was Chairperson of the Bergen County Historical Sites Board and a member of the Hackensack Bicentennial Committee.

He was a former adjunct Professor of paralegal studies at Bergen Community College and a former Judge of the North Arlington Municipal Court.
