Obituary

Abdal Aziz Zaid Muhammad was born on January 4, 1992. He was the third son and the sixth child born to Al Hajji Marzuq Zaid and Al Hajjah Zarifa Muhammad. He was a fun and curious baby and toddler who was loved and doted upon by his older siblings.

As a youngster, he enjoyed martial arts and was trained under Kushinda Lamarr Thorton in his New Breed Life Arts Program for many years where he earned a Brown Belt First Degree in Shotokan Karate. He was an avid Boy Scout in the Masjid Malcolm Shabazz Boy Scout Troop 007, where he was a Life Scout, was inducted into the Order of the Arrow and was working on Eagle Scout requirements. He held 15 badges including Totin' Chip and Dentistry. On the Troop's many camping trips, as Totin' Chip he was designated to construct an axe yard and instruct the newer Scouts about axe yard safety and the proper use of tools. During the winter trips, he especially enjoyed snowboarding. He was also a member of the Color Guard for Lt. Governor David Paterson's Inauguration in 2008. He was described by his Scoutmaster as a fearless Scout who enjoyed hiking, rifle shooting and archery and all-around Scouting.

He attended The Clara Mohammed School in Harlem (of Masjid Malcolm Shabazz) and The Opportunity Charter School. Mosaic arts was a favorite pastime. He also aspired to attend dental school.
