He spent many years working with his father sanding, finishing and installing wood floors. He could fix almost anything.

Over the years, Milton struggled with alcoholism. It was one of the biggest fights of his life. Gradually, he started to make some changes but the loss of his oldest son Tyler really broke his heart. It was something he said he'd never get over.

Milton could light up a room with his voice and laughter. He was that guy. He could easily turn a dull moment into a happy one. He was that guy. He could also go from zero to one hundred real quick. He was that guy. His quick wit and humorous personality would make you forget that you were even mad at him. He was just that guy.

On Sunday, November 1, 2015, he was called to eternal rest. His Son, Milton Tyler Gregory, preceded Milton in death. He leaves behind to cherish his memory: his Mother, Omelia Gregory; his Father, Joe Gregory, Sr.; his Sister, Loretta Bowe; his Brother, Joey; his Sister-in law, April Gregory; his two Children, LaToya Binford and Myles Gregory and Son-in-law, Michael Binford; his three Grandchildren, Ruqayyah, Rayhan and their Mother, Susej and another Granddaughter, Maleah; his Niece and Nephews, Justin Bowe, Brittany Bowe and Isaiah Gregory; and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
