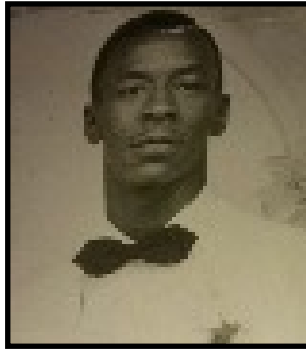

Edward Yulsee Walker, Jr., affectionately known as “Scar” was born on May 31, 1935 in Trenton, New Jersey, son of Hattie Mae Presley and Edward Abel Walker, Sr. He received his early education in the Trenton Public School System. When his family relocated to Jersey City, New Jersey, he continued his education in the Jersey City Public School System. During his youth he would also attend Grace Church in Jersey City.
