Robert M. Morris began his journey in life August 25, 1932, a journey which ended November 16, 2015. The first of four children born to Robert S.E. and Ismay S. Morris. He lived most of his 83 years in Manhattan, New York. He was baptized and received his early Christian Training under the leadership of his Godfather, Rev. Robert H. McLean, Pastor of the Ebenezer Wesleyan Methodist Church.
