OBITUARY

Dr. Leo Stallworth, Pastor and Founder of Healing From Heaven Temple, was the son of the late Mr. Sam and Pearlie Stallworth. He was born in Mobile, Alabama on April 6, 1936.

His formative years were spent in Mobile and Indiana, attending elementary and high school in the public school system. He was a track star in high school. As a young boy, he saw in the distance through the woods, a burning bush that was not being consumed, which caused him to become so frightened that he ran away.

He joined the Army and served for three years. It was there that he was introduced to Jesus and filled with the Holy Ghost. He later became a Foreign Missionary and a National Evangelist for the Church of God in Christ. Bishop Cleaveland, Bishop Owens, Bishop Sexton and Bishop Gaylord were a few of his spiritual fathers. He has touched the lives of thousands with his ministry of faith and miracles.

He received two degrees, Doctor of Religious Philosophy and Doctor of Divinity from Bible College and Seminary of Virginia and Florida. He established five churches across America finally settling in New Jersey where he met his wife, Sister Catherine Patricia Bentley. They were married in 1973. Pastor and Sister Stallworth had two girls and the one son he always wanted.

Prophet Roger Deciur, prophesied to him that his blessing was across the river in New York City. He saw in a vision Healing from Heaven Temple and God brought Pastor to this very location "across the river". His motto is "if God said it, it's got to happen". If you asked Pastor how are you, he always replied "The Lord is Blessing". His word to all men and women of God is to READ, READ, and no matter what's happening "Be faithful to God and shut your mouth and listen".

He leaves behind to cherish his memory: his friend and confidant, Catherine "Pat" Stallworth; his children, Desirae, Kyyeetha, Leo Jr., Nikey, Chee Chee and Cresha; three sons-in-law, Edwardo, Carl and Wilber; two sisters, Carrie Broughton-Irving, Pastor Jessie Stallworth and one brother, Pastor James Stallworth; sixteen grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and a host of relatives and a world of friends.

Pastor Stallworth read his Bible three-four hours every night and prayed through the house always. If everyone was here today who he was a blessing to, there would not be a place large enough.
