***Sean*** as a baby, until graduating from high school, fellowshipped at the Greater Harvest Baptist Church.

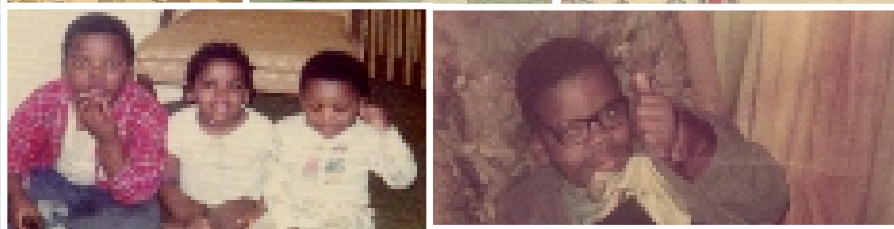
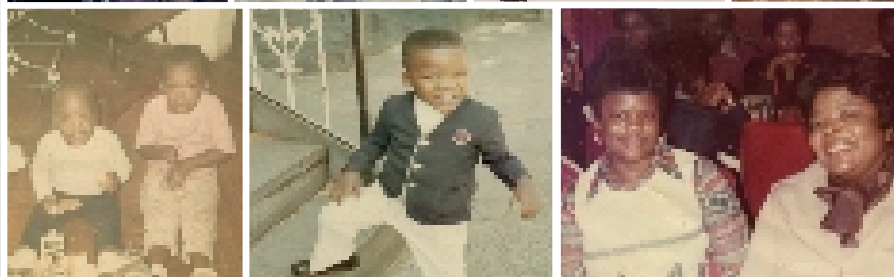
***Sean*** worked at Verizon for twenty-five and a half years.
