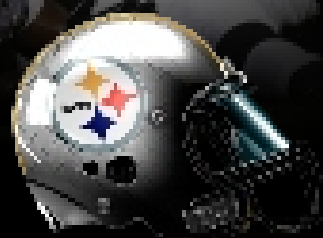


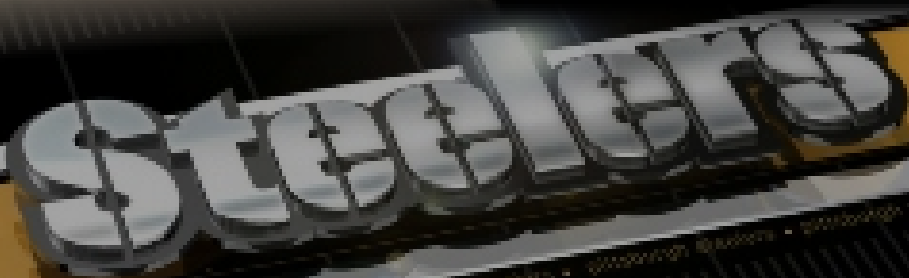

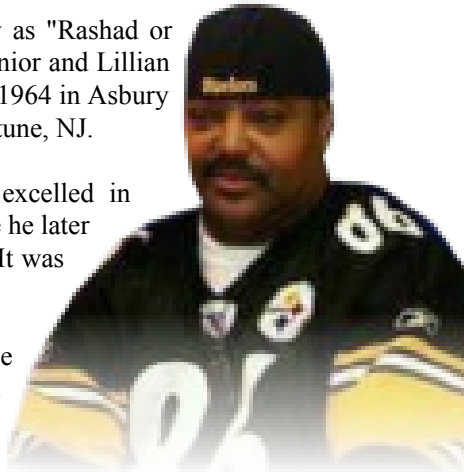
After many years of dating, Hazel and Bonnie united in holy matrimony on November 15, 2008. They continued their life together.

Psalm 27:1-14

The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
