I miss you offering up all of your food and even mine.

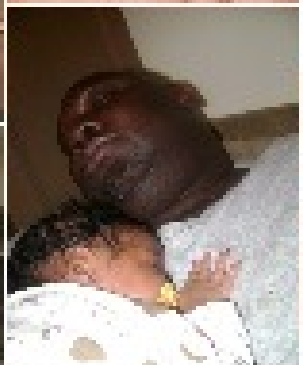
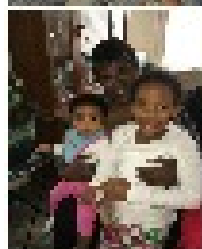
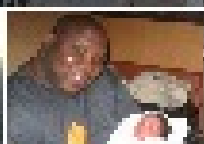
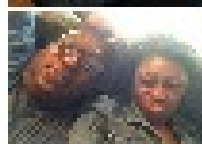
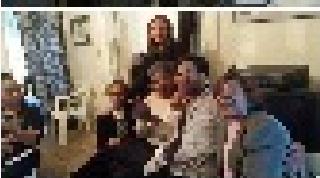
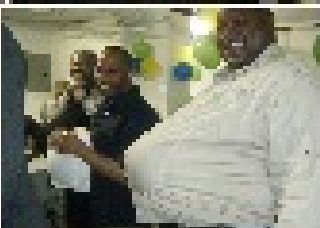
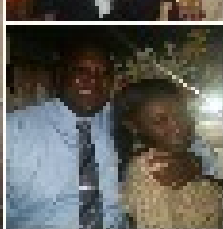
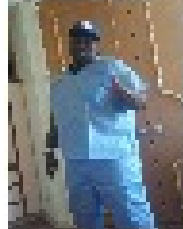
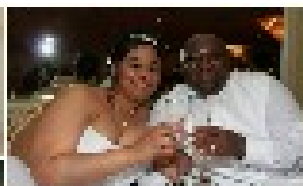
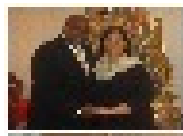

As Stephon would say, “P.E.A.C.E” (Positive Energy Activates Constant Elevation). He lived that.

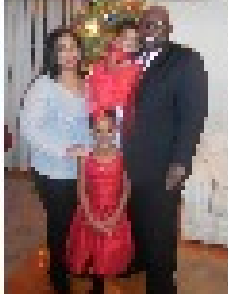
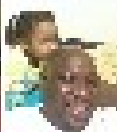
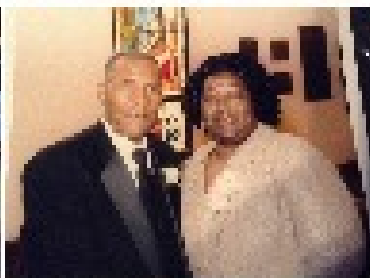
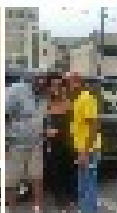
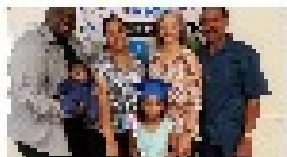
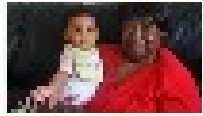
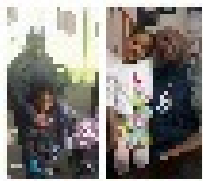
