Tommy Lee Jackson, Sr., 58, of the Bronx, New York was called home on Tuesday, January 5, 2016 in Atlanta, Georgia after a brief illness. Tommy was born on March 12, 1957 in Greensboro, Alabama to the late Bessie Lucinda Williams Jackson and Johnnie Hayes of Greensboro, AL. The Jackson family moved to the Bronx in 1966 where Tommy spent the majority of his life. He moved to Jackson Heights, Queens in the late 1980's and back to the Bronx in 2009.

He received his G.E.D. from Monroe High School in the Bronx, NY where he also received some college credits. Tommy trained as a Golden Glove boxer at the Webster Police Athletic League (PAL) under Maynard Stovall. A hard worker, he began his employment as a school aide at PS 85 in the Bronx in 1978 where he worked for more than 38 years until his passing. At the time of his death, he was also employed part time by Temco as a custodial cleaner. Tommy very proudly served in the New York Army National Guard as a SP-4 for twenty-two years before retiring in 2006. In a relationship that spanned over 32 years, Tommy married the former Marisa Petrocelli on January 2, 2004.

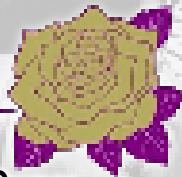
