Obituary

Waldie Anthony Blint was born at the Public General Hospital in Mandeville, Jamaica on the sixteenth of January, 1976. He was the fifth child of Lilabell Petrie and Glenroy Blint. He attended the Porus Basic School and Porus Primary School and later moved onto Porus High School.

Waldie was fond of getting dressed on Sabbath to go to church with his grandmother and sister and his two cousins, Gary and Sandra. Like every other child, Waldie was quite mischievous and often got into trouble with his grandmother who had a strict way about her. He loved his sister who usually tried to protect him at all cost and sometimes would end up sharing his punishment with him, since one didn't do anything without the other. From interfering with the sugar and milk to cutting down trees that were meant for important use.

Waldie was adventurous and often times would pull apart his grandfather's radio and try to put it back together. Patricia remembers vividly when he pulled their grandfather's radio apart just to see "why the man inside the radio was talking, what wire made him talk." Of course, he received a punishment for that, and so did his sister Patricia who tried to help him fix it.

This kind of curiosity followed him into his adult life but in a more productive way. He was able to pull down and handle electronics in a very efficient way. Nothing seemed difficult for him once the idea entered his mind.

Waldie had suffered with asthma but this did not deter him from any form of activity. He enjoyed track and field and did this very well. He used this method to escape trouble and once he started running, you couldn't catch him.

He had a tender heart towards those who were sick and spent sleepless nights by his grandfather's bedside along with his sister watching over him. Even if he got in trouble with his grandma, whenever she got sick he would be the first one to ask, "Grandma, you want me to get you Phensic mam, for your pressure?"

Waldie was one the neatest persons I know, he liked to look good and kept his surroundings clean. He was very particular about the use and placement of his personal belongings.

Waldie will be sadly missed by his parents, Lilabell and Glenroy, his siblings, David, Elsworth, Marcia, Patricia, Naomi and Dennis, aunts and uncles, especially aunty Novlet and uncle Causmore, many nieces and nephews and a host of other family members and numerous friends.

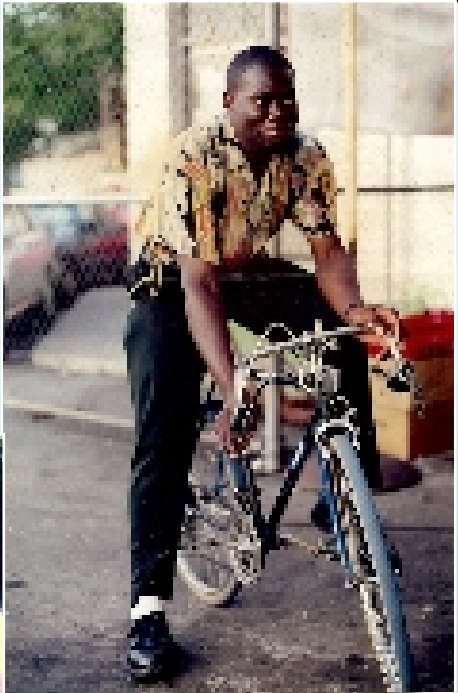
