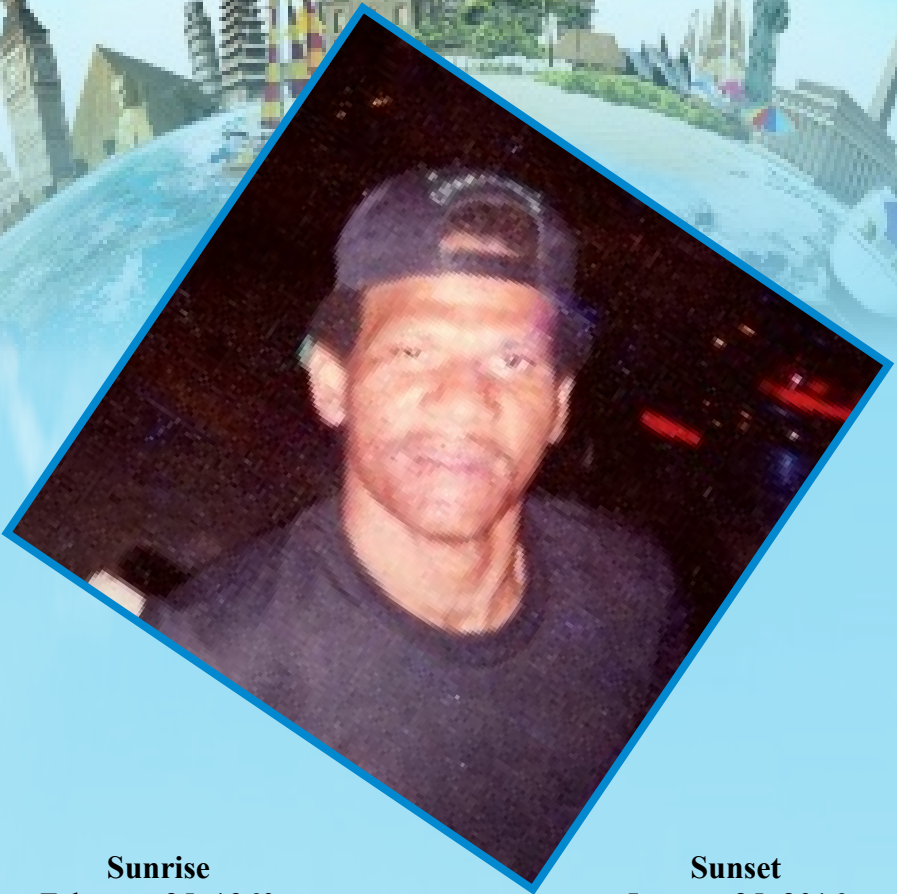

Sammie Levern Davis was born on February 25, 1960 in Baltimore, MD to Willie Lena Glover and the late William Davis. He resided in Passaic, NJ most of his life, before relocating to Columbia, South Carolina and Apopka, FL.

Sammie attended the public schools of Passaic. In May of 1969, while playing on the railroad track behind Pulaski School, he suffered a life changing injury due to an accident.

At the age of twelve, Sammie was baptized by Rev. Frank England and became a member of the Second Timothy Baptist Church of Passaic.

In 1978, he left Passaic to fulfill his passion for traveling.

Sammie was preceded in death by his father, William Davis.
