

Dona was born in Portland, Jamaica, W.I., to David Mason and Nella Mason and had four older sisters, Enid, Pauline, Elreth and Sharon. She later gained a younger sister Faye. Her immediate family consists of five children (one deceased) and seven grandchildren. Dona was an ardent care giver to her mother until she passed away in 2003

Dona attended the Cardo Park Home Economics and Catering School in Port Antonio, Portland, Jamaica, where she studied House Craft Catering for nine months, which included Social Development Skills such as Child Care, Catering, Cookery and Grooming. She worked as a Domestic Engineer in Jamaica prior to immigrating to Bronx, New York, USA.

Dona was a hard worker, quiet and reserved, she was not a contentious person. At times, she could be a comedian and a good team player. Although she had health issues with hypertension and diabetes, she still continued to care for her grandchildren as best she could.

Dona became a member of the R.A.I.N. Boston East Neighborhood Senior Center in December 2015 where she enjoyed activities and made new friends. She looked forward to attending each day. (She will be missed).
