Life Reflections

Henry Roy McKenzie, Sr. was born on March 17, 1925 in Dinwiddie, Virginia, son of Ruby Lee Williams McKenzie and Harvey McKenzie. At a young age, his family relocated to Cranford, New Jersey before they moved to Roselle. He was educated in the Cranford and Roselle Public School Systems and graduated from Abraham Clark High School.

“Roy” was a United States Army veteran of World War II. He served with various outfits in the European Theater as a combination welder and had served briefly with the Military Police.

On June 6, 1948, “Roy” married the love of his life, Camille Cassine Sumner at her Spruce Street, Roselle home with Rev. James Crawford presiding. This union was blessed with 4 children, Karen M., Carolann, Camille and Roy. His main focus was on his family. He loved spending time with his grandchildren who affectionately called him “Papa” and cooking for his family.

A welder by trade, Mr. McKenzie worked for Hartz Mountain in Bloomfield, New Jersey and was then employed by Alcoa for many years before he retired.

He had attended Heard African Methodist Episcopal Church and had been a member of Acacia Lodge #23 – F & AM - PHA both in Roselle.

Henry Roy McKenzie, Sr. departed this life on Sunday, February 7, 2016 at Clark Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Clark, New Jersey at the age of 90. He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Camille McKenzie, parents, Ruby and Harvey McKenzie and a sister, Cora Lewis.
