Reflections - The Life of H Servant

Overseer Richard Frederick Christmas, was born in the home of his parents the late Elder Richard J. Christmas and Missionary Nettie H. Christmas on November 4, 1943, in the City of Montclair, New Jersey.

Together with his only sibling Rev. Ileathern Christmas McLeod, Overseer Richard Christmas, was educated in the Montclair, New Jersey school system.

He later received an Associate Degree from Drake College of Business in

Newark, New Jersey. A man endowed with a strong work ethic, at the age of nine, delivered groceries for Maple Deli, Inc. At the age of twenty he purchased that same business. Always a champion for youth, he established the Maple Deli Minority Scholarship for graduating Montclair High School students.

His professional career also included employment with New Jersey transit and subsequently was a dedicated worker at the Essex County Prosecutor's Office until his retirement in October 2011.

Overseer Richard Frederick Christmas, received his early religious training at Trinity Temple Church of God In Christ, under the leadership of his god-father the late Bishop Frederick Douglas Washington, the late Elder Kelmo C. Porter, Jr. and ultimately, Bishop Norman L. Prescott.

A man full of wisdom and knowledge, it was predestined that during a church service his eyes and heart was drawn to the lovely, beautiful and charming, Lady Diana Mullings. As ordained, this union was sanctioned in holy matrimony on April 23, 1988. He has two sons, Wesley Keith Mullings and Dana C. Mullings Christmas.

A warrior for Christ, he served as a Youth Minister at Trinity Temple Church of God In Christ. Answering a higher call to ministry, he became an ordained Elder through the Church of God In Christ, World Wide under the auspices of the late Bishop Chandler David Owens. He also served at Cotton Temple Church of God In Christ, under the Leadership of the late Bishop Charles H. Cotton. He worked faithfully as the Elder over the Youth Church and President of the Men's Department. With esteemed dedication, he served as Finance Officer for the Garden State Jurisdiction of New Jersey, also in the same capacity for the Third Jurisdiction of New Jersey; Vice President of the Evangelism Department under Bishop Norman L. Prescott.

He was also a recipient of Theological Studies through Evangelical Bible Institute, located in Newark, New Jersey under the leadership of Dr. Nathaniel L. Screven.

Endowed and eager to fulfill the work of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, he accepted the call and founded Whosoever Will Church of God In Christ, February 8, 1998, within the City of Plainfield, New Jersey. His wife worked faithfully by his side and together through Christ, they touched the hearts of many.

With commitment and dedication during August 2007, he pledged his utmost support to the vision of Covenant Kingdom Ministries International under the auspices of Bishop Charles W. Harris, Jr., Prelate and Bishop Calvin N. Singleton, Sr., Assistant Prelate. He served as District Superintendent and Chairman of the Executive Board and by divine ordinance was elevated to most high office of Overseer on June 28th, 2015.

Overseer Richard Frederick Christmas, walked and served hand in hand by the side of Bishop Charles W. Harris, Jr. His love and dedication for both his spiritual leader and Covenant Kingdom Ministries International was extraordinary and highly exceptional.

He traveled to cities within New Jersey and other states as designated. He was a man of highest integrity, faithful, dependable and a humble Shepherd.
