He resided in Passaic, New Jersey most of his life.

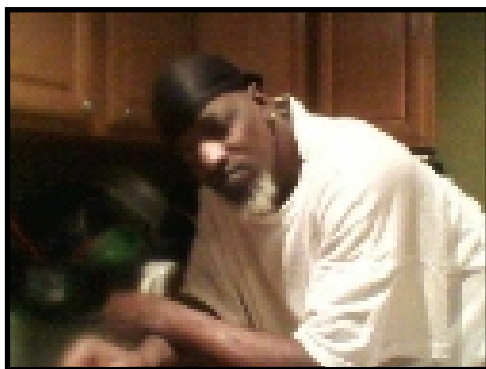
