Marcia Elaine Blake was born on June 2, 1955 in Christiana, Jamaica, daughter of Jacqueline Clarke and Francis Lawrence. At the age of 12, she migrated with her family to Newark, New Jersey. She attended Newark Public Schools and graduated from Weeqahic High School.

Upon graduation from high school, Marcia attended and graduated from Essex County College in Newark with an Associate Degree in Accounting. She then attended NJIT (New Jersey Institute of Technology) in Newark and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Administration.

Marcia began her work career as a Key Punch Operator for Bambergers and later for AT&T both in Newark. She was employed by GPU Energy (formerly Jersey City Power and Light) in Summit and Morristown, New Jersey and remained there for 30 years before she became disabled.
