<u>Obituary</u>

Alfred A. Albany was born in Allendale, South Carolina, and was the oldest of five children born to the late Richard and Mary Bryant Albany.

As a young boy, Alfred attended Beautiful Day Baptist Church in Allendale, and later, Harden Academy and Voorhees Industrial High School, both in Denmark, SC. Following high school graduation, Alfred matriculated at South Carolina State College, graduating in July of 1940, and remained a supportive and contributing alumnus until his death.

Alfred had a happy demeanor and enjoyed being around people, particularly those at East Haven, where before long, he was highly admired by its many residents and staff members.

Along with his snappy dress, Alfred exuded coolness, class and sophistication. He had a positive spirit, and a great sense of humor, always finding time to listen and offer advice to family and friends. Alfred was a man of great inner strength and faith, as evidenced by his nearly 100 years of good living. He will be truly missed by his family members and many friends.
