Tyrone Johnson, Sr. was born on February 6, 1958 in Newark, New Jersey, son of Margaret Pugsley Johnson and Pete Johnson. He attended Garfield Elementary School in Newark.

As a youth, he moved to Roselle where he attended Lincoln School and Grace Wilday School before graduating from Abraham Clark High School with the Class of 1977.

Tyrone was employed by the Roselle Board of Education for over 30 years. He began as a Custodian and would later become the Head of Security at Abraham Clark High School.

In 1985, Tyrone met Yvonne Hamilton and they were joined in holy matrimony. This union was blessed with three children, Tyrone, Jr., Tyria and Tylenna. Together they would also raise Yvonne's daughter, Lafeya Hamilton.

Tyrone enjoyed playing football. He played Roselle Pop Warner Football on the Pee Wee and Midget teams and played on the high school football team. He would share his love of the game as a coach for Pop Warner and Abraham Clark High School. He also coached basketball at the high school.
