NA was well liked respected & will truly be missed.....💔



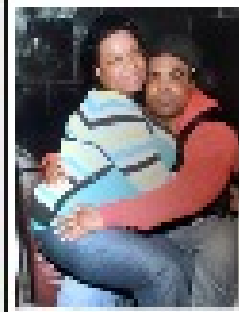
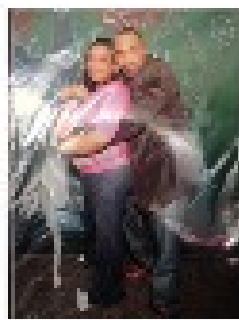
