Obituary

On the evening of March 29, 2016 at 7:47 pm **Elcie** passed away after a battle with cancer; while being attended by family and staff members at Long Island Jewish Medical center In Soysset, New York. Elcie was 59 years young. While battling her illness her love for family and friends never wavered.

Elcie Leon was born in Limbe Haiti on July 1st, 1956 she was the first daughter of Martin Jean Baptiste Leon and the third child of Bleutte Mesidor. Elcie went to school and completed her primary education in Cap-Hatien at Chez les Meres Blue, her secondary schooling was at St. Francois D'Assise In Port-au-Prince, Haiti. She started her medical education in Ecole de medicine in Haiti and completed her doctorate in Dominican Republic. She learned a lot about the value of hard work from her family. This strong work ethic she had from an early age shaped the rest of her life. After growing up in Haiti she moved to New York City, where she began her career as an educator where she taught OB-GYN at Columbia University and she was a well-respected. Elcie was constantly inspiring and helping others and always with a smile to make you feel a little better and she touched thousands of people lives due to her easy approach, caring nature and a fun loving woman. She enjoyed volleyball, cooking, baking.
