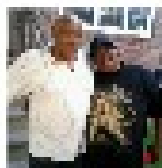
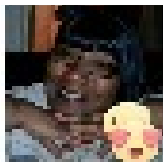

Yetta was a member of Greater Harvest Baptist Church, Newark, New Jersey.

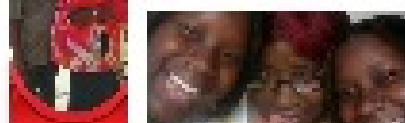
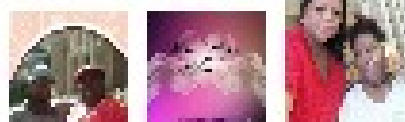
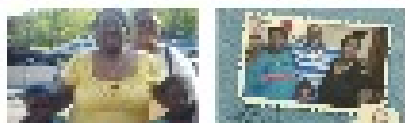
Yetta often visited The House of God Church in Orange, NJ with her aunt Deaconess J. Edwards.

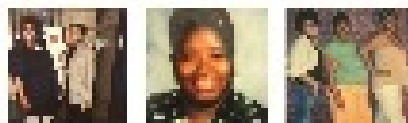
