Hettie James was born on October 11, 1923 in Camden, S.C.

She received most of her education in Ridgewood, NJ and graduated from Ridgewood High School. She was tireless worker. She worked many years for the Grand Union Corporation and received a service award upon her retirement. She also received a certificate of appreciation as a lunchroom aide from The Glen Rock Public School System for 14 years of dedicated service.

Hettie was a faithful member of The Metropolitan AME Zion Church of Ridgewood, NJ. She

served for many years on the usher board. She was also the President of the Lay Council of the church for several years. She loved working with children and youth, which led to her teaching Sunday school.

Additionally, she was an officer in the local Women's Home and Foreign Missions Society.
