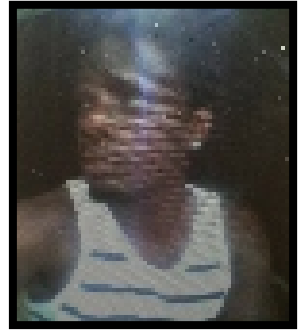

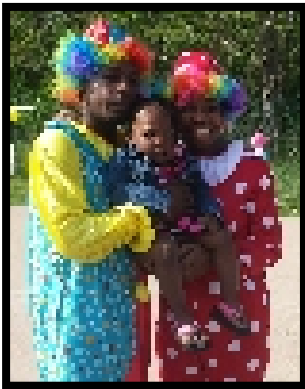

Demetri later moved to Irvington, NJ and attended Irvington High School where he graduated in 2013.

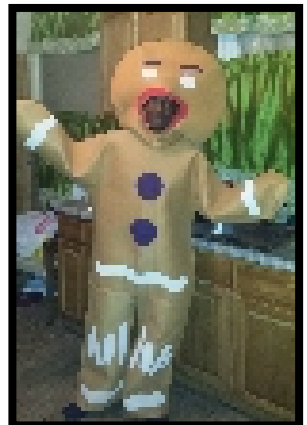

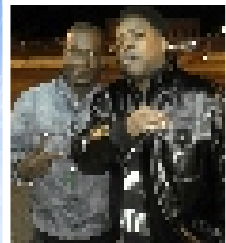
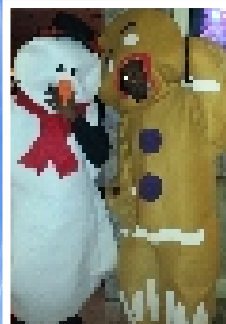
Miss Me, But Let Me Go
