During his time at Abraham Clark High School, he attended the Union County Vocational School in Scotch Plains, New Jersey where he received a Plastics Production Certificate in 1987 in conjunction with his high school diploma.

Reared in a Christian home, from a child he was known for his singing ability. Ronald, like his mother, never disappointed when given the opportunity to sing to the glory of God. He was baptized and became a member of First Baptist Church in Linden under the leadership of the late Reverend G. George Abnathya.
