Reflections of Life

Eddy Nicolas was born on March 11, 1942 in Jacmel, Haiti. He was the one and only child of his mother, Cherizianne Nicolas. He attended school at the “Charlesmoravia” in Jacmel. At a young age, Eddy moved from Jacmel to Port-au-Prince, Haiti, where he learned and became a mechanic. Eddy began his career and worked in Damien as the Head Mechanic in charge, and he was also a driver for more than ten years. Eddy had a big heart, not only did he work in Damien, Eddy would also help friends, neighbors, and anyone who needed help when it came to car trouble. Eddy’s generosity reached so many people especially the youth. He would shelter them, helped them, and paid for their school education.

In 1962, Eddy met his sweetheart, Isma. Eddy has seven children; five with Isma and two of his children they raised together. Eddy worked hard and raised all his children. He provided them a home, education, loved them all. Eddy wanted to strengthen his relationship with God, and started going to church. Shortly after, in 1996 Eddy converted as a Seventh Day Adventist and received his baptism. In 2012, Eddy migrated to the United States where he lived with his wife and daughter in New Jersey. Eddy would be best described as a family man; he was always with his wife, he never left her side. Eddy did everything with his wife; Every morning Eddy went for a nature walk with his wife. If his wife was going to the store, Eddy was with her. When his wife was preparing dinner he was by her side keeping her company. When he was home he enjoyed looking out the window and had funny nick names for the pedestrians passing by. Eddy was very friendly, he would talk to anyone and everyone. No matter where you were from and what language you spoke he would speak to you in Creole. If you were Haitian, he would speak to you in Creole. If you were American and English speaking, he would still speak to you in Creole.

Eddy is the grandfather of eight and great grandfather of two. Eddy will be best remembered for his kind heart and generosity. On May 22, 2016, Eddy was called home to be with the Lord.
