Robert carried his Christian roots with him throughout his life, which was instilled by his grandmother, the late Bishop Ophrie Crawford. He loved gospel music and often, without reason, would belt out a hymn. He always knew and loved the Lord.

Most of all Robert loved his family and had a close bond with his mother. On his last days at the hospital, Robert made sure his siblings and parents were okay before he departed; he searched for assurance in our faces. Robert loved everyone and he was very happy with the love he was shown on his last days at the hospital by all his friends and extended family.

Robert's last words to his mother were, "Ma, are you good?" Her response was, "I'm good if you're good, we're good together." He told her to go home because she was tired and needed to rest. With that confirmation, he shortly afterwards closed his eyes and peacefully slipped away; to go to his Lord.
