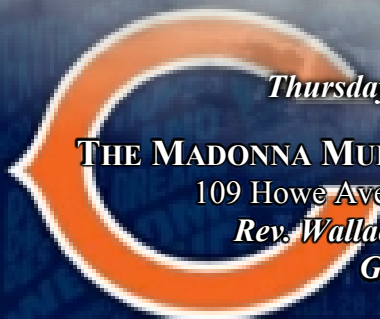

Myself

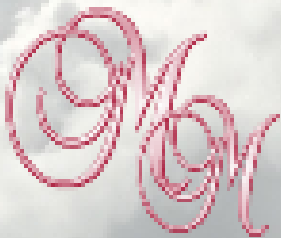
