

Reflections of Life

Luther Johnson, also affectionately known as "Newt" departed this life on Saturday, August 6th, 2016. He was born on September 24th, 1935, to the late George and Ida Johnson of Passaic. He attended and graduated from the Passaic Public School system. He proudly served in the U.S. Army from October 1958 until receiving an Honorable Discharge in September 1960.

Luther was united in Holy Matrimony to Dolly M. Baker on December 31, 1961. From this union three children were born, Lisa, Marty, and Gina. Luther was a very active father who was involved in his children's public school education and activities. He enjoyed traveling with his family and engaging in activities that promoted their independence.


