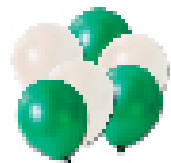
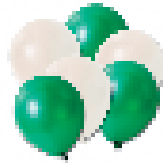
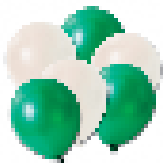
## Obituary
