Obituary

Beverley Richardson (nee Fletcher) passed peacefully on August 18, 2016 after battling pancreatic cancer since her diagnosis on May 28, 2016.

She was born in Kingston, Jamaica on May 2, 1951 to Ida Stewart and Roy Fletcher. She graduated from St. Martin's High School in 1968 and most recently from ASA Institute with an Associate's degree in Occupational Studies (Medical Assisting) in 2009.

In 1972, she married Wayne Richardson and from their union welcomed 4 children – Nina, Sean, Natalie and Lloy. Her early career began at CMP followed by more than 20 years at Jamaica Public Service in Jamaica and most recently MTA New York City Transit Authority in Bronx, New York.

She was described by former work colleagues as internally driven and highly motivated evidenced by a number of leadership positions throughout her professional career. She was an active member of the faith community at Trinity Baptist Church. Beverley was a good listener and confidant and known to never pass judgment on anyone. Her hobbies included entertaining, gardening, cooking and dancing.

Beverley is survived by her four children and six grandchildren, Khloe, Kyle, Daniel, Darie, Jana and Jonathan.
