## Life Reflections

**Mary Katherine House** was born on January 20, 1935 in Leesburg, Florida, to the late Arthur House, Sr. and to the late Cassie Berry.

She attended public school in Leesburg, Florida. In school, she was an outstanding basketball player. She was known for her dance moves and excelled as an exceptional Majorette for her high school band. After completing high school, she decided to leave home with five dollars in her pocket and travel to Dade City, Florida to find a job to help her father. She passed a restaurant, and met the owner Mr. Herbert who helped her get a job (AFTER NOT TELLING THE TRUTH ABOUT HER AGE). She told Mr. Herbert she was 18 years old, and had her fingers crossed behind her back. While working for a few months, she met her best friend Delores Williams. As time went on she then met Alfred Steele Jr. who she later married. She then moved to Newark, New Jersey after his tour in the service. Mary House was called the "Harriet Tubman" of her family because she brought each one of her siblings to New Jersey one by one, with the exception of two brothers who were in the military. Not only did Mary House help her brothers and sisters, she also helped extended family and friends. She raised her family in Newark until moving to Linden, New Jersey in 1969.

She was later employed at Rutgers University of Newark for over thirty years until her retirement. After retirement she spent most of her time helping the elderly, gardening, and assisting anyone with transportation needs. Mary House inspired her children and grandchildren with ambition, values, and morales. She wanted them all to strive and work hard to achieve their goals.

Mary was a devoted member at Friendship Missionary Baptist Church for over twenty-five years. She served *faithfully* as a Missionary and Usher. She "FOUGHT A GOOD FIGHT OF FAITH, STOOD HER GROUND, AND DID NOT WAIVER."

Mary Katherine House departed this life on August 21, 2016 at Trinitas Regional Medical Center in Elizabeth, New Jersey at the age of eighty-one. She was predeceased by Alfred Steele, Jr. and Bruce Hall; stepmother, Rosa House, a sister, Evelyn Lowery and two brothers, Robert Hall and Arthur House, Jr.
