

John Willie Robinson was born on September 12, 1940 in Bladen County, North Carolina to mother Maude Patterson. John W. Robinson was the adopted son of mother Emma Jane Robinson and father Ernest Leno Robinson.

John W. Robinson graduated Booker T. Washington High School located in Clarkton, North Carolina in 1958. He would later become a trained Sunday School teacher at Pierces Chapel Methodist Church located in Bladen County, North Carolina. Upon migrating from the south to the north, John W. Robinson resided in New York and finally established residence in Paterson, New Jersey in 1961. He later became employed as a machine engineer and silk screen printer with Hawthorne Prints located in Hawthorne, NJ from 1976-2004. John W. Robinson also worked as a stock handler with Toys "R" Us located in Paramus, New Jersey from 1974-2004. John W. Robinson became affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters- Local Union #522. As of 2006, John Robinson became employed as a security guard for Securitas, based out of Jersey City, New Jersey until the time of his transition.

Shortly after settling in Paterson, New Jersey, John W. Robinson met, fell in love, and married the late Essie Lee Washington. The two would create a family of their own and raise a daughter, Kimberly D. Ellis, which they both so dearly loved.

John W. Robinson was known to close family members and friends as "John" and "Uncle John Willie". John W. Robinson was mostly known for his self-lessness and willingness to help everyone that crossed his path. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, and shopping with his granddaughters who cherished every moment of his time. In his girl's eyes, he would move mountains to ensure they didn't go without.
