Frank Green, Jr. (lovingly known by family and friends as “Jukey”) was born May 22, 1969 to Frank Green, Sr. (S.C.) and Patricia McNeil (Paterson, NJ). Born and raised in Paterson, New Jersey, Frank attended Eastside High School before moving to South Carolina where he graduated from Maywood High School in 1988. He later returned to Paterson and attended the Don Bosco Trade School where he studied mechanical engineering.

At the young age of nineteen, he landed a job with the New Jersey Transit. He dedicated the next twenty-one years of his life working as a service mechanic for this well-known company, retiring at age 41.

Frank enjoyed the sport of football and during his earlier school days, he played for the heavyweight team Blue Demons, under the coaching leadership of Lou Mathis. Later, Frank made his contribution to the community by working with other youth, as the coach of multiple softball teams - including Federation and the YMCA. He was an avid New York Giants fan. He also worked as a volunteer for the Paterson Habitat Homeowners Annual Cook-out, and events hosted by the North 3rd committee groups.

In addition to a good old fashion Bar-B-Que, “Jukey”, as many referred to him, loved playing cards, and most of all spending time with his family. He was also a former member of the Grace Chapel Baptist Church, in the city of his birth.

On Saturday, September 3, 2016, “Jukey” entered into the rest of the Lord, taking his bright smile and contagious laughter with him. He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, James and Christine Alston (both of Paterson, NJ) and his paternal grandparents, Leroy and Venether Green (Lynchburg, SC).
