Even though our hearts struggles to fathom why someone so wonderful, caring and full of life was taken away from us. We know she would not want us to be sad but be merry and strong.

Waking up in the morning and going about your day is just not the same. That smile that brightens up the room as soon as she steps in, those words of encouragement, wisdom and comfort that we've grown accustomed to hearing at every encounter are now memories. Memories all of us here today will cherish for as long as we live. You would never know that Georgia was battling cancer if she didn't tell you because her countenance was so pleasant and her attitude was always positive. She was a true warrior; better known as an angel dressed in human form.

God sent Georgia Brown here on September 29, 1975. Born in Sparling, Manchester to parents Myra White and "Desmond" Brown of Frankfield, Clarendon. Georgia was the third of six siblings on her mother's side and the first of three siblings on her father's side (Donnya & Chrisandra). Growing up, Georgia attended Frankfield Primary School and Edwin Allen Comprehensive High School prior to migrating to Hackensack, New Jersey in 1992 with her mother Myra and sisters Tamar, Babbet, Rickell, and Marion (brother deceased). A Graduate of Hackensack High School in 1996, Georgia obtained a Baccalaureate Degree in Social Services from an HBCU St. Augustine College in Raleigh, North Carolina. Georgia spent time traveling, modeling, working and serving others. She was truly a free spirited soul! For 11 years, Georgia worked with the New York State as a Rehabilitation Specialist serving the the mentally disabled population. Though the work was challenging, she believed in the human aspect of all her clients.

In 2010, Georgia met the love of her life, Anthony Blair and the two have been Inseparable. Anthony made her the happiest woman alive when the two got married on August 1, 2015. Anthony wasn't the only one she married that year, she dedicated her life to Jesus. Georgia got saved, baptized and became a member of the Queens Church of the First Born. Georgia wanted to put her treasures into Jesus's teaching. "Preparing for what is important", she would often say. Georgia realized that working and gaining money was necessary ... but her goal was to get closer to God. Reading and listening to God's words; loving others, and living a purpose filled life was more pleasing to God.

Georgia never gave up hope of surviving this Cancer. She fought a great battle for two years, exploring chemotherapy and other holistic options with her husband and God at her helm. On September 3, 2016, Georgia lost her battle to stomach cancer (Cancer Treatment Center of America, PA); however, the lessons she has taught us is enough to last a lifetime. Georgia will be missed dearly by many family, friends, God Children, and her spouse Anthony Blair.

Georgia, your mission here on earth was accomplished, Angel! God was ready to return your wings. We are not saying goodbye but to say see you later warrior, Georgia.
