**Francesca** attended the Newark Public School Central District: including West Kinney Middle School and later attended Central High school, where she was actively involved in School Club's and was always selected to Model in the School Fashion Shows, which she loved dearly. She graduated from Central High School in 1976 and continued her studies at Essex County College of Newark, NJ. She also attended the United Bible College & Seminary of Orlando, FL receiving her Bachelor's Degree in Theology and many other studies through the Evangelical Bible Institute Satellite School under the late Dr. Nathaniel L. Screven.

Francesca was employed by the Newark Municipal City Hall in the late 1970's under former Mayor, Kenneth A. Gibson. In 1982 she was employed with the NJ Department of Agriculture for several years and then later began a career in Federal government beginning February 6, 1986, where she was an employee for over 30 years. Francesca (Fran) quickly became a member of the DEA "family" because of her wonderful and warm personality. She began her career as an Office Assistant at the U.S. Department of Agriculture. On August 1, 1992 she became an employee at the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in New York City. She was promoted several times: Secretary at the DEA Northeast Laboratory, Secretary for the DEA New York Division 20, Intelligence Research Specialist and Senior Intelligence Research Specialist, which was her position at the time of her death. She will be deeply missed by her DEA "family" for not just the exceptional work that she did, but also because she was such a great friend to them all.

Francesca grew up knowing the Lord at Bethesda COGIC under the late Bishop James H. Screven, the late Dr. Nathaniel L. Screven and First Lady Jean Screven. Later continuing in ministry and was currently fellowshipping at Grace Reach Ministries COGIC under the present Pastor Paul Shelly (her brother) and his wife, First Lady Evangelist Sylvina Shelly where she served the Lord. She was a dedicated and faithful member with a heart that was always willing to help wherever help was needed and served in the Department of Hospitality and Helps. She loved to bake and would always make a big delicious cake that would just melt in your mouth, for church events and for the holidays. She loved to sing, one of her favorite songs was "Who Side Are You Leaning On, I'm Leaning On the Lord Side".
