She wasn't going to baby you – but if you needed someone to listen, give good advice, and honest feedback – Rhoda Jones was who you went to. She'd always tell you what you needed to hear – not what you wanted to hear.

Although she would rather spend time by herself than with a crowd of people, Rhoda knew how to celebrate. She would kick off her birthday festivities right after Christmas and was known to keep the party going through spring.

She was a quiet and private person, so you might be surprised to know that she used to watch and participate in the roller derby; she loved eating dessert before dinner – and in some cases, for dinner; and "Hot in Here" by Nelly was her favorite song. She loved black and white movies, plays, musicals and all the award shows about them. She would always say "I am going to pick the Oscar winners" and she would be right.

Rhoda leaves to cherish her memory: two daughters, Jennifer and Kimberly; grandchildren, Aneshia, Christopher and Kimaya; her mother, Ruth; two great grandchildren; a host of other family and friends, and joins her beloved granddaughter, Ashley in heaven.
