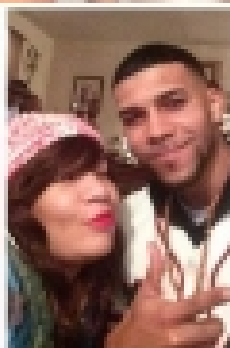
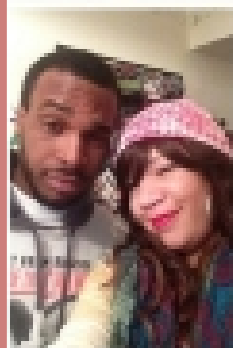
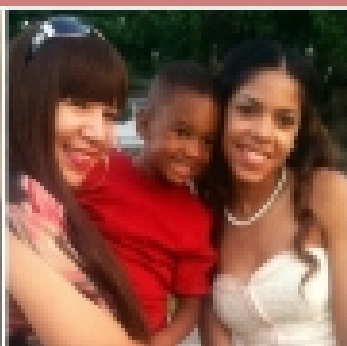
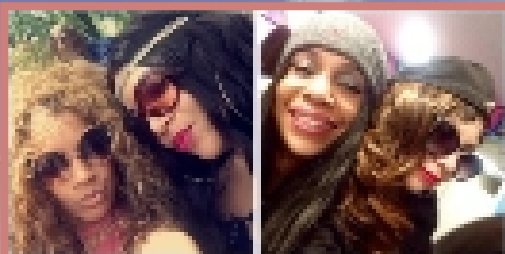
On September 21, 2016, Renisha “Nit” Edwards departed this life.
