Donna Sharon Wright, born on May 24, 1952 in Englewood, NJ, was called home to be with the Lord Jesus Christ on October 3, 2016.

Donna graduated from Dwight Morrow High School in Englewood, NJ in 1970. She received her Associates Degree in Graphic Design from Fortis College. She worked as an Administrative Assistant at Westbury Press for thirty years. As a teenager, she took interest in the political issues of the time and attended peace marches and rallies in New York.

At a young age, she also discovered her passion and talent for the arts. Not only did she paint, draw and sketch, she also was an avid goer of museums and showcases all around New York City (The Metropolitan and the Guggenheim was amongst her favorites). In addition to Donna's affinity for the arts, she had a love for a variety of music (everything from classic rock to gospel) and was blessed with a beautiful voice.

Although shy, Donna was encouraged by her aunt, Cora to use her beautiful voice in the Grace Bible Class Young Adult Choir and later in the senior choir. She assisted her aunt with directing the children's choir for many years. Some of her favorite songs to sing were "Someday", "Peace Be Still", "He's My Light", and "Father I Stretch My Hand To Thee". Donna loved the Word of God. Her favorite verses were Psalms 27:1, 13, and 14 *The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? ¹³ I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.¹⁴ Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.*
