Obituary



Lionel Hart Campbell affectionately known as "**Percy**" was born in St. Ann, Jamaica on November 23, 1946 to his parents, Clarice Tait and Urel Campbell.

Percy attended Charlton Primary School, he then later attended York Castle Secondary School.

In 1969, while visiting the parish of Manchester, he met and fell in love with Myla Ferguson. He later moved to Trelawny where they got married. Their union bore six children, Malachi, Sharon, Raymond, Mark, Donna and Damian. He then decided to move back to St. Ann. Percy loved his farming, his children would never go hungry. No one could touch any of his children and get away with it. His mother loved him dearly. She always ensured that he and his family were ok.

Percy along with his wife and children migrated to New York on May 13, 1991. He got a job at Hot Pot Jamaican Restaurant where he worked for a few years. In 1998, he decided to pursue a job

in the hospital, where he worked for seventeen years.

In June 2015, Percy was diagnosed with Lung Cancer. He underwent treatments, however in September the cancer had spread rapidly throughout his body. He lost his battle to cancer on October 20, 2016. He was a jovial and comical man, even to his last days.
