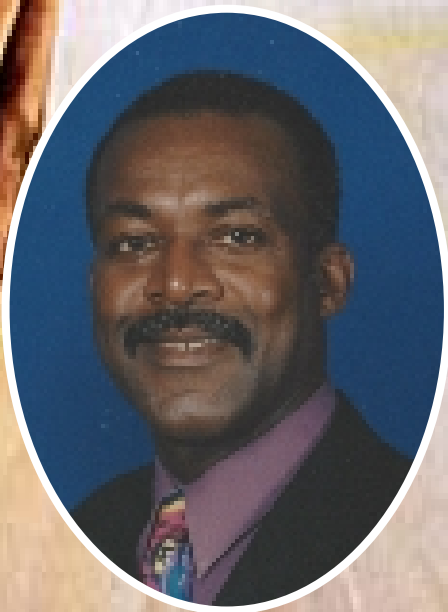

Obituary

Reginald Jackson, was born on May 27, 1943 in Newark, New Jersey to the parents of the late John Martin Jackson and Evelyn Roberts Jackson. He was the loving brother of Ronald, Jacqueline and Wayne.

Reginald graduated from West Side High School in June of 1961. He attended Rutgers University in Newark, New Jersey where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice. Immediately following his high school graduation, he enlisted into the Navy in September of 1961. He was honorably discharged as an Electronic Technician after serving his country.

After being discharged, Reginald focused on his career. He joined the Newark Police Department in 1967 ending his career in 1980 as a detective. During his years in law enforcement, he worked alongside his father at Jackson's Realty. He made a career change that further helped him to serve the community through the Division of Welfare and Social Services before retiring.

Reginald met the lovely, Etta Edwards and they formed a union on May 21, 1994 at First Baptist Church of Nutley. They were married for twenty-two years until his untimely death.

Reggie was always known for his special gift of singing. He participated in multiple choirs at Metropolitan Baptist Church, which allowed him to sing praises to God. He was a firm believer of cleanliness, where he was known in the neighborhood for keeping the streets spotless.
