Eulalie Wright was born on September 19, 1939 in Sumter, South Carolina, daughter of the late Leroy and Martha Wheeler, Sr. She attended the Sumter Public School system. At an early age, Eulalie accepted Jesus Christ as a personal savior. She was a member of Heard A.M.E. Church in Roselle, New Jersey.

She was married to the late Robert Wright on March 15, 1958. With this union, they were blessed with two daughters, Tonya and Patricia.

Eulalie was employed at Pharmacap Pharmaceutical Company in Elizabeth, New Jersey for eleven years. She was also a Seamstress and a well-known neighborhood Babysitter for 30 years.

She enjoyed weekend trips to the casinos at Atlantic City along with shopping for new items or just trying out clothes. She would reserve time to straighten and roll her hair after sewing shoulder pads into her jackets. Mrs. Wright made sure to take exceptional care for her long fingernails. If you needed a meal or a couple of dollars or just someone to talk to, she was there for you. Eulalie was always home cleaning something, or babysitting friends and families' children.

On Thursday, November 3, 2016, she transitioned from this life at Somerset Woods Rehabilitation Nursing Center in Somerset, New Jersey at the age of 77 after a long illness.

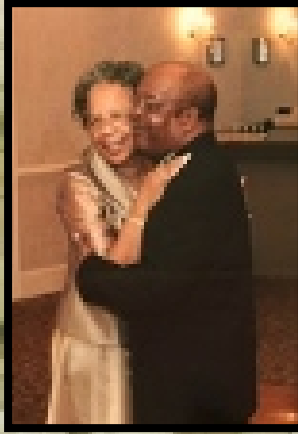
