

In 2015, Jonas realized he wanted to turn his life around and enrolled in school and began working. His long term goal was to purchase a house for his family.


On June 5, 2016, Jonas was united in Holy Matrimony to the love of his life, Shante Lewis. Whenever you saw one you saw the other.
