# Obituary

**Mr. Benjamin Abrams Jr.**, was born July 6th, 1942 to the late Mildred Gregory-Abrams and Private First Class Benjamin Abrams Sr. who was killed in combat while serving his country in the United States Army. Benjamin, AKA ... Ben confessed Christ at an early age in Fairfield, Alabama and received his elementary education there.

His mother Mildred relocated in Queens New York during Ben's teen years, where he received his public education. After graduating from high school he began his career in technical training at Grumman's Aircraft in Long Island, New York where he learned the craft of working on the fuselage of the airplanes until the company went out of business. Ben never stayed idled; he learned the trade of handy man in remodeling homes and repairing home fixtures of all kinds.

In 1959, Ben married his first wife and this union was blessed with three children, Yvette, Tyrant and Benjamin III. Ben's technical training was instrumental in his pursuit of securing a job with the New York City Public Transportation Subway System as a rail track repairman.

In 1994 Ben met and married his second wife, Minnie Monroe-Abrams and this union was blessed with the adoption of his wife's grand daughter, Michaela. In November of 1998 Ben suffered a heart attack and retired from his job in 1999. When Ben got stronger, he began to do little jobs in home improvements; he was highly sought after for his skills in this work.

Ben's love for family and friend was the epitome of a Christian because the trade mark for a Christian is "Love".

Ben leaves to cherish his memory a loving wife Minnie, his daughter Yvette, two sons, Tyrant, Benjamin III and his adopted daughter Michaela, one brother Johnny Daniel. He leaves seven grand-children, Sebastian, Caleme, Tianna, Tiffany, Shanice, Tyrina and Tyshuna. Also left to cherish his memory are two great-grandchildren, seven step children and their children, a host of nieces, nephews, cousins of five generations and many friends.
