Mother Marian Hall was born in Spring Hill, North Carolina on June 24, 1921 to John and Susie Shields. She later migrated to New York City. She attended the Combination Business and Locksmith School, and upon completion she became the first female licensed locksmith in New York State.

Mother Hall met Milton Hall in 1943 and they were united in holy matrimony on October 21, 1945. No children were born to this union. The Lord blessed Mother and Brother Hall with a successful locksmith business; they gave much back to the community by securing their doors, locks and even providing employment to many. Mother Hall was a people person and could relate to any generation.

Mother Hall was baptized in Jesus name in 1950 and she received the precious gift of the Holy Spirit in 1958. She has been dedicated to the work of the Lord since that time. She was a faithful and dedicated member of the Greater Refuge Temple under the leadership of Bishop W. L. Bonner. In 1966, during the remodeling of Refuge Temple, Mother Hall signed off on every lock that was installed in the church by their firm. Mother Hall loved her church.

Mother Hall was a Prayer Warrior, she had many spiritual tools. The one she loved most was prayer. The Prayer Room was her second home. She would say, prayer is for our perfection, prayer releases the power of God in our lives and this leads to spiritual growth and service. We can visualize Mother Hall sitting in the chair by the pole in the Prayer Room waiting for seekers to arrive.
