Obituary

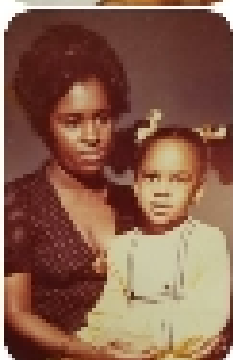
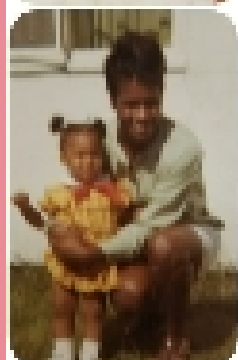

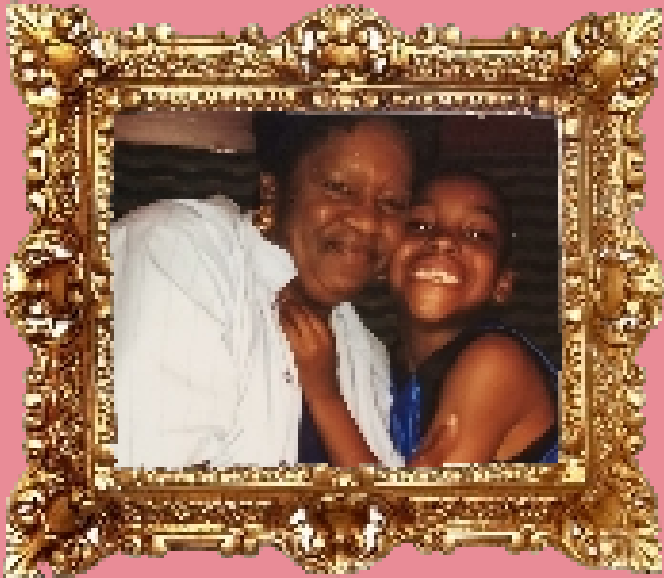
