Have a pool party?

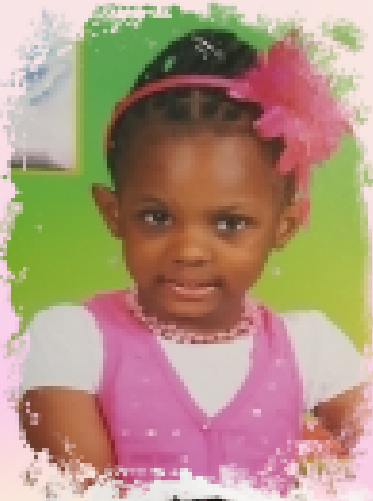
Or go to the beach?
