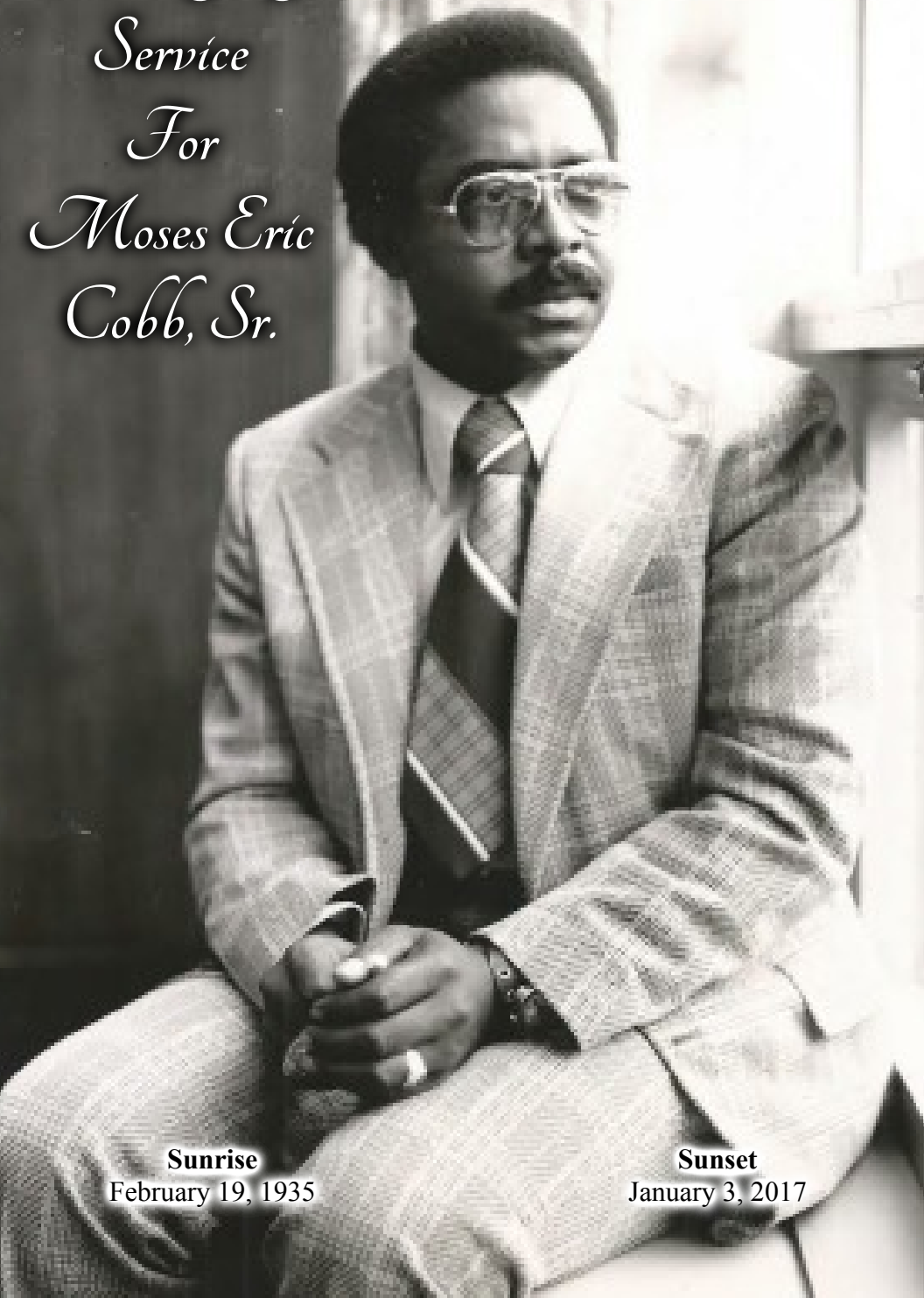

Reflections of Life

Moses E. Cobb Sr. was born February 19, 1935 to the late Annie Lou and Belton Cobb in Union Springs, Alabama. On Tuesday, January 3, 2017 God called Moses to eternal rest from St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center, Paterson, NJ.

Moses received his early educational training in the Bullock County Alabama Public School system. At an early age his spiritual roots began to grow at the Great Hope A.M.E. Church in Midway, Alabama along with his 7 siblings. He was a dedicated and faithful member of the church, when he became a father, he made sure his children received their proper Christian training by attending church. He furthered his education at the famed Tuskegee Institute, Tuskegee, Alabama where he received his B.A. degree in science. He later received his Masters degree from Seton Hall, University, South Orange, NJ. He was employed as a teacher and later a principal in the Newark, NJ Public School system for 25 years before retiring in July 1997.

Moses served in the United States Army where he was on active duty from October 12, 1959 to April 11, 1962. He received an honorable discharge. He continued to serve in the United States Army Reserve until his retirement as a Lieutenant Colonel.

He was preceded in death by his one sister and his five brothers.

Moses leaves to cherish wonderful memories, three children; Paula (Cobb) Kelly, Eric Moses McRoy, and Moses Eric Cobb Jr., one daughter-in-law; Konjit Hailemichael McRoy and six grandchildren; one brother; John Cobb of Chicago, IL, as well as his former spouse; Betty Cobb of Maplewood, NJ. He is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, relatives and friends; and a very devoted friend, Judy Taramas.

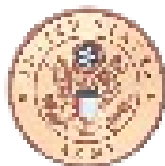
