Obituary

Felix George Jones affectionately known to his family and close friends as 'Dada' was born in St. Mary, Jamaica on January 1st, 1924 to parents, Obedia Jones and Zepporah Lemonius. He would often talk about his love for his 'Granny' who raised him and ensured that he went to school.

He moved to Kingston in his early twenties to pursue better job opportunities. Mr. Jones met the woman of his dreams, Delcie Strachan who he affectionately called 'D'. His last job as a security guard was for Con Edison in New York City before retiring.

Dada was a conversationalist and would use any opportunity to engage in conversation with anyone. He was very knowledgeable in a number of areas and always had an opinion which he would not hesitate to let it be known.

He loved to listen to the news or read the newspaper and watch sports. He had a love for cricket and basketball and loved playing dominos.

The last year of his life, he spent doting on his great grandson Kenzie. He could often be heard calling him "Kenzie come to grandpa" or while playing with him you would hear him say "throw di ball to grandpa man".

He passed away on Sunday, January 8th, 2017 at St. Barnabas Hospital after a short illness.

He leaves to mourn: his wife Delcie Jones, his daughter Jacqueline, his granddaughters, Chantel, Anisca and Aneisha, his great grandson Kenzie; also, Junior, Georgia, Summer, Shelley, Chivvone, Sharon, Teneisha and many more family and friends.
