Those we love don’t go away, they walk beside us everyday.

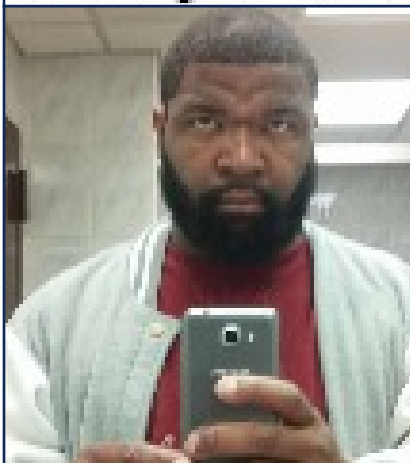
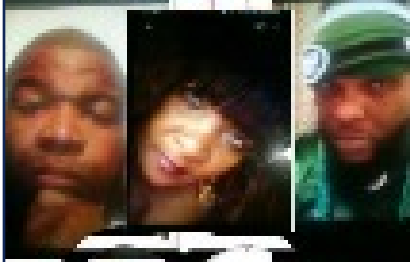


On The Loss of my Brother
